Purpose

No scout should be excluded from participating in a summer camp experience due to financial reasons. For this reason, Troop 81 attempts to provide limited number of Camperships to provide assistance.

Policies

- Camperships are available to registered scouts in Troop 81, Loveland, CO.
- Campership Applications must be received by the Troop 81 Scoutmaster no later than May 10.
- Camperships are granted based on need and available funds. If there is more demand than funds then the troop committee will decide.
- Camperships are a combination of a grant and a loan. Scouts are expected to participate in fundraisers to repay half of their granted campership.
- If a Scout fails to attend or cannot attend summer camp, the grant money must be returned to the Troop.
