


Scouting America *Troop 81*: Librarian Handbook

Duties: The Librarian of Troop 81 oversees the care and use of troop books, pamphlets, and magazines, and holds a list of merit badge counselors. They will check out their materials to scouts and leaders and maintain records to ensure everything is returned. They may also suggest the acquisition of new literature and report the need to replace or repair any current holdings

Chain of Command: The Librarian acts as a normal member of their patrol and isn't expected to miss too much time as an active member of their specific patrol, so reports to their Patrol Leader. But in the name of their duties as Librarian, they will report to the Assistant Senior Patrol Leader and work closely with the Troop Advancement Chair.
